## Safeguarding in Scouting



**Reporting safeguarding concerns at events.** It's possible for safeguarding concerns to happen at camps and events, including welfare concerns affecting our young people. The updated Yellow Card states that everyone has a duty to report all safeguarding concerns to the HQ Safeguarding Team and this also applies during camps and events. If you're making a report to the HQ Safeguarding Team, please include details of the camp or event lead (alongside the person(s) line manager, if known) and inform the camp/event lead that you've made a report to the HQ Safeguarding Team (as they might want to reach out to the HQ Team as well). The HQ Safeguarding Team will follow the usual process and liaise with the relevant Lead Volunteer/Commissioner. If you're not sure what to do, or if you want to check if a report has been made, please contact the HQ Safeguarding Team.
